The amazing play Geometrisches Ballet / Geometric Ballet (a tribute to Oskar Schlemmer) by Ursula Sax has been waked from its sleeping beauty slumber by Semjon H. N. Semjon and will now premiere in a new production in 2019.

In summer 2018, on behalf of Ursula Sax, Semjon H. N. Semjon, Ursula Sax' gallerist, has concluded a contract with the Dresden production company for theatre and dance, tristan Production | Management | Event, to produce a new version of the *Geometric Ballet / Geometrisches Ballett*.




Premiere

Geometrisches Ballett/Geometric Ballet will premiere in September 2019 at Radialsystem Berlin. Then it will open the Bauhaus-Festival in Dessau, followed by, also in September, another stage version on the reconstructed historical Appia stage at the HELLERAU - Europäisches Zentrum der Künste. Artistic direction will lie in the hands of the choreographer Katja Erfurth from Dresden. The accompanying music will be composed by Sascha Mock, also from Dresden.



Making of the Copies

We were interested in keeping the more than 30 dance sculptures (the felt Body Masks, the Air Dresses made of textile/ Tyfex and the Body Cardboards) in the present state of preservation, which wouldn't have been possible, when using the original costumes. Wear, staining and even greater damage would inevitably have been the consequences. Therefore, the original dresses had to be copied for the rehearsals and following performances on various stages.


Crowdfunding Campaign


